## **Revolutions Skating Club Membership Packages**

Summer 2021: All ice sessions will be drop-ins and invoiced based on attendance. There are no monthly commitments needed for summer ice times.

- Mondays: 1 hour = \$20, 2 hours = \$30
- Wednesdays: 1 hour = \$20, 2 hours = \$30
- Thursdays: 1 hour = \$20

\* To be billed for 1 hour, please attend either the 1<sup>st</sup> hour (4p-5p) or the 2<sup>nd</sup> hour (5p-6p).

**All skaters will be required to pay a one-time, yearly RSC fee of \$25.00 to help with administrative costs.**

**All skaters will be required to maintain USFS membership (yearly).**

### **How do I sign up for Revolutions Skating Club?**

1. Complete your RSC Membership on-line on our website
2. Sign all forms and waivers for Revolutions Skating Club
3. You will be contacted after completing your RSC membership to confirm details.

### **What will I be invoiced?**

1. One-time, yearly, USFS membership \*Price depends on your skating level
2. One-time, yearly RSC membership fee of \$25
3. Monthly skating sessions (during season)
4. Drop-in sessions (as needed and during summer)

### **How do I pay my invoice?**

1. From your billing email, use the “View and Pay Now” button to view your invoice and pay by credit card. This is our preferred method of payment.  
\*Please note that we do not take American Express.

*US Figure Skating* is the governing body of all figure skating in the United States.

Revolutions Skating Club is proud to be an affiliating member! It is required that all of our skaters register as members of US Figure Skating, in addition to RSC.

Below are the membership categories and prices, which are in *addition* to the Revolutions Skating Club membership fee:

**BASIC SKILLS:** This is for all skaters who have not yet tested in the USFS testing system. (If you aren't sure, you most likely have not tested) \$16

**INTRODUCTORY:** This is for the very first year that a skater begins USFS testing or is preparing to test. This first-year price is \$35. Subsequent Introductory \$29.

**US FIGURE SKATING FULL MEMBERSHIP:** For all Revolutions Skating Club members who are entering their second or more year of skating with US Figure Skating in the testing structure. Board members are required to have this membership and any parent may also join US Figure Skating with this membership. First Family Member: \$65 Subsequent: \$29

**COLLEGIATE:** This membership covers all (4) years of college for any US Figure Skating member who wishes to remain a member while attending college. \$70 for all four years, total.

\*The yearly USFS Membership term begins July 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

## **Revolutions Skating Club: Return To Skating Covid Guidelines (as of September 1, 2020)**

\*Please note that the following guidelines MUST be followed by all skaters, coaches and parents in order to participate in RSC skating sessions. Parents of all skaters are expected to monitor their skater before coming to the rink for any signs of illness, fever, cough, etc. We will not be taking temperatures of our skaters or coaches but do expect the health of all participants to be the number one priority.

\*These guidelines are subject to change according to Pitkin county regulations.

1. All skaters, coaches and parents must wear a mask when entering and exiting the ARC building.
2. Skaters do need to wear masks when skating.
3. Social distancing of 6 feet apart will be in place for all skaters, coaches and parents, both on and off the ice.
4. Skaters may use the restroom, one at a time. Use of the rest of the ARC facility is prohibited.
5. The lobby / warming area is closed to all. Skaters, parents and coaches will be using the dedicated areas in the rink to put on and take off skates.
6. Designated areas for putting on skates will be marked, 6-feet apart. Skaters may bring one bag for their personal items and all items must remain in their closed bag while skating. \*All skater areas must be kept neat, tidy and organized in your personal bag.
7. Skaters will have 10 minutes to put on their skates, and 10 minutes to take off their skates. All should exit the building as quickly as possible.
8. Skaters should come dressed ready for the ice session and off-ice warm up must take place outside, with safe distancing.
9. Skaters will enter at the mezzanine door (by the hockey office) and exit by the door at the corner of the ice rink, that opens to the softball fields, one person at a time. All entrances and exits will be marked with the appropriate signage.
10. All skaters must check in with the RSC coach who is monitoring the sign-in sheet.
11. A maximum number of 25 skaters and coaches, combined, is allowed per session.
